

Contemporary Drum Rudiments

The grid displays 15 contemporary drum rudiments, each with a unique name and a corresponding stick diagram:

- "Choo-choo": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Chatachichi": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
- "Flamacue-diddle": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Cheese Chain": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
- "Paradiddle-flafla": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Diddle-flafla": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
- "Shirley Murphy": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes and three-note grace notes (3) above the first and third strokes.
- "Ripits": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes and two-note grace notes (7) above the second and fourth strokes.
- "Shockadiddle": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Chutra-cheese": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes and five-note grace notes (5) above the second and fourth strokes.
- "Cheese-cha": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Chut-Cheese": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
- "Flam 5 flafla": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Five-a-diddle": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
- "Irish 5": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the first and third strokes.
- "Flaflam drag": A pattern of six strokes (up, down, up, down, up, down) with accents on the second and fourth strokes.
